SUBJECT: Summary of Changes: HAFBI 13-204, Uncontrolled Airfield Operations (UAO)

1. Below is a list of minor changes incorporated into the HAFBI 13-204 due leadership change over, user input, and author's discretion. Changes made do not discourage the intent or operations under the provisions in which the participating/tasked units and HQ ACC/A3 approved the original signed document.

a. **Change 1:** Changed all mention of Land Mobile Radio (LMR) "**Ramp Net**" to "**LMR Tower Net**". **Rationale:** The LMR Ramp Net is not the net flightline drivers currently use to access the airfield's Controlled Movement Area during airfield operating hours. Tower Net is not only utilized during airfield operating hours, its audio transmissions is recorded 24/7. A recorded net will assist investigators if and when UAO incidents/accidents occur. Note: All agencies affected are capable of obtaining LMRs with Tower Net capability and have been notified of the pending change.

b. **Change 2:** Line addition to paragraphs 2.12, 13.1, and 6.26: "**ODOs may notify the Fire Department to activate the airfield lights in the event of emergencies only**". **Rationale:** In the event of an emergency, ODOs may not have enough time to commute the distance to the Airfield Lighting Vault located behind the Control Tower. Note: 49 CE/CEO has agreed to this addition as written.

c. **Change 3:** Line addition to paragraphs 4.1 and 16.1: "**and 586th FLTS. Note: The OG/CC may authorize additional base agencies to come within 100 feet of any runway, Taxiway Golf, and or the North Ramp when the airfield is closed as the mission dictates**". **Rationale:** Enhances unit mission flexibility.

d. **Change 4:** Corrected grammatical errors throughout entire document for better understanding and readability. **Rationale:** Obvious.
